
Recreation Participation by Season

Recreation Rental Income Analysis





Paradise Bay Water Park

- Pool Passes went on sale March 1
 - 1,338 passes sold
 - 3,554 total pass holders
- Regular Season May 28-August 9
- Post Season weekday tot and adult swim hours, along with weekend open swim hours were offered through Labor Day
- Facility Visits: 87,365 including 51,115 daily admissions
- 809 Swim & Dive lesson participants

 - Planting beds




