### Calendar/Newsletter:

You will receive a paper copy from your child's teacher and you will also be able to find each classroom's newsletter, calendar and other forms on our website. Although we, for the most part, adhere to the listed activities there will be times when teachable moments occur and we will sway from scheduled activities if the children are showing interest in another area.

**News and Notes:** Each day your child's instructor will post the daily schedule outside with information pertaining to learning experiences, the story or other information that may be of interest. You can take a picture as you pass by it, so after school you can talk to your child about something they may have done at school that day.

**Clothing:** Please dress your child in comfortable clothes that are easy for him/her to manage. Please note that the school day is filled with activities that may be messy and could result in stained clothing. Please dress your child accordingly. **For all ages, please send a spare change of clothing and an extra mask or two in your child's backpack**, for whatever need arises, toileting accident, a mishap at the water table or a juice spill, your child may need to change. Having clothes at school allows them the ability to change and move on with the day, rather than having to wait for someone to bring clothes if needed.

**Please note: We cannot change your child.** If further assistance is needed and you are unavailable we will need to contact someone on your emergency list.

**Snack:** Kiddie Campus Preschool is a peanut free environment, so all snacks and 100% juice are provided for your child by the preschool. Please send a towel in your child's back pack so we can go outside or in the gym and socially distance while we enjoy our snack as a class.

**Arrival and Departure:** Please remember that arrival is 9:00/1:00 and dismissal is 11:30/3:30 please remember to wait outside the building at all times. If you are running late please call 630-620-7322 and someone from the office will let you in, as Sunset Knoll is closed to the public. When picking up your child please bring your own pen to sign the departure log each day. If you are unable to pick up your child, we will only release your child to a person(s) you have authorized on your transportation agreement, as well as, a written note from the parent stating who is allowed to pick the child up from school. No child will be released without authorization. **Make sure anyone picking up your child has their state ID with them.**

Please remember that a quick good bye is best, especially at the beginning of the year. Transitions can be challenging, especially when we have been at home with Mom and Dad for a while. We will help them settle in to the routine of school and before you know it, they may even forget to say good bye because they are so excited to start their day. If you are concerned we can always give you a quick call to let you know how your child is doing.
