**LEARNING THE ALPHABET** According to the book, Make Early Learning Standards Come Alive written by Gaye Gronlund, alphabet letters in isolation do not have meaning to young children. When children are shown that letters grouped together represent their names, items and products in their world and tell stories that they love to hear, the alphabet takes on new meaning. Helping children develop their alphabet knowledge is an important step in the reading process. It is important to surround children with a print rich environment so that the whole alphabet is being represented.
