



# POOL RULES

## PARADISE BAY GENERAL RULES

- Children under 10 must be accompanied by a paying adult 16 years of age or older.
- Children under 5 must have an adult 16 years or older within arms reach at all times.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim suit over a swim diaper and tight fitting rubber pants.
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere in the water park.
- Street shoes, food, glass, skateboards, roller skates and bikes are not allowed on pool decks.
- No running allowed anywhere in the facility.
- Strollers are allowed in designated areas ONLY.
- No snorkels or glass masks are allowed.
- Walk with caution. Surfaces may be slippery when wet.
- Outside food and drink is not allowed in the water park.
- All flotation devices must be U.S. Coast Guard approved and labeled as such. All children wearing flotation devices must remain within arm's reach of a swimming adult. A limited number of flotation devices are available for use by all patrons on a first come, first serve basis.
- Patrons must wear a clean, lined swim suit. Street clothes, cut offs and spandex will not be permitted. Clean, white T-shirts will be allowed.
- Diving is only allowed in the Dive Pool.
- Eating and drinking will only be allowed in the concession and picnic area.
- Foul language, foul gestures, spitting, or physical contact is prohibited.
- All other state and local health codes apply.
- Patrons should make any special needs known to the staff.
- Persons with open sores, skin infections or suffering from an infectious condition will not be allowed in the water.
- Deck furniture available on first come; first serve basis/lounge chairs reserved for adults.
- Furniture may not be placed in any pool entry and must remain in a position so as to allow four feet of access on the parameter of all pools.
- Outside lawn furniture will not be allowed at any time.
- Water guns and water absorbent balls are prohibited. Approved water toys are only permitted in Turtle Cove. No flotation devices are allowed.
- Lombard Park District reserves the right to make additions and/or alterations to these rules when deemed necessary for the health and safety of all.
- Lombard Park District reserves the right to revoke season passes or suspend daily admissions of individuals for violation of facility rules.
- Lombard Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate discharge from the water park.

## DIVING BOARD & DIVE AREA RULES

- Use caution when diving.
- Head and neck injuries can result from improper diving.
- Divers must be able to swim the width of the dive well.
- Parents/Guardians are strongly encouraged to observe the activity prior to deciding to allow their child to participate.
- Only one person allowed on the board at a time. Persons in line must wait until the previous diver has safely reached the pool ladder/stairs before climbing the diving board ladder.
- Divers must dive/jump straight off the end of the board (not to the side) and exit the diving area at the nearest stairwell.
- Running, cartwheels, handstands, flips of any nature, reverses, inward dives and multiple bounces on the diving board are prohibited.
- Glasses, toys, flotation devices, goggles, keys and metal objects are not allowed on the diving board.
- Flotation devices or assistance from anyone in the water will NOT be permitted.
- Parents may not catch their child in the water.
- Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate discharge from the water park.

## WATER SLIDES RULES

*Wipeout, Splashdown, Pipeline, Sidewinder*

- Maximum operational load 1 person, 300 lbs.
- Children under 48 inches tall are not permitted on the Bowl Slide/Wipeout.
- Children under 42 inches tall are not permitted on the Drop Slide/Splashdown, Body Slide/Sidewinder or Speed Slide/Pipeline.
- Eyeglasses, jewelry, sunglasses or goggles are not permitted.
- Swim wear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation are not permitted.
- Only one rider to enter the flume at a time.
- Chain riding is not permitted.
- Slide must be ridden feet first lying on your back with legs firmly crossed at the ankles and arms folded across the chest.
- RIDERS MUST WAIT FOR THE ATTENDANT'S SIGNAL BEFORE STARTING THE RIDE.
- Do not uncross your legs or attempt to sit up until you come to a stop in the pool.
- Do not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide.
- At the end of the slide, obey all instructions by the pool attendant and exit quickly.
- CAUTION: For safety reasons, pregnant women and persons with heart conditions or back trouble should not ride this slide.
- Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate discharge from the water park.

## GATOR CROSSING RULES

- You must be able to reach the overhead cargo net without assistance to use the Water Walk/Gator Crossing.
- Only one person at a time will be allowed on Gator Crossing.
- Swim fins, masks, goggles or flotation devices are not permitted.
- You must be able to swim to the side.
- Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate discharge from the water park.

## TURTLE COVE RULES

- No horseplay, pushing, shoving or running is allowed.
- Turtle Cove is designed for families with children under 48 inches tall. Users of this area must use caution at all times while engaging in activities and must be accompanied by a person 16 years or older.
- Individuals 16 years or older must be accompanied by a child under 48 inches to enter Turtle Cove.
- Deck furniture must remain 4 feet from water's edge.
- The slide is for individuals under 48 inches tall. Slide riders must be able to stand in line and ride the slide unassisted. All riders must enter and exit slide on backside, feet first only.
- No standing, running, climbing, pushing or shoving on the slides.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim suit over a swim diaper and tight fitting rubber pants.
- Changing areas are provided in the locker rooms.
- Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate discharge from the water park.
