How Games Will Look

Our goal for this program is to increase each player's game knowledge and provide an enjoyable experience, so that they build an everlasting bond to the game. With this in mind our games will typically consist of at least two innings. Each at bat will consist of everyone on the team hitting three balls off of the tee (number of hits may vary based on time and flow of games). Each ball being fielded will be thrown to first base. On the third hit, the batter will run to first base and stay. This process will repeat until each player on the batting team has had a chance to hit. The last batter will then run all the bases and teams will switch.

We will need volunteers to oversee first base, third base, and an outfield position. The main job of these volunteers is to direct the runners to the correct base, make sure players are paying attention, and to bring some extra energy to the field.
