Playdough is an engaging, relaxing activity that helps to strengthen and develop fine motor muscles. Here is the recipe used in our classroom.

2cups flour

1 cup salt

2 ½ teaspoons cream of tartar

1TBS vegetable oil

2 cups water

Food coloring of choice

Mix all ingredients together and cook on medium heat until solid and pulls away from side of pot. Cool, knead and store in airtight container. Lasts about a month.
